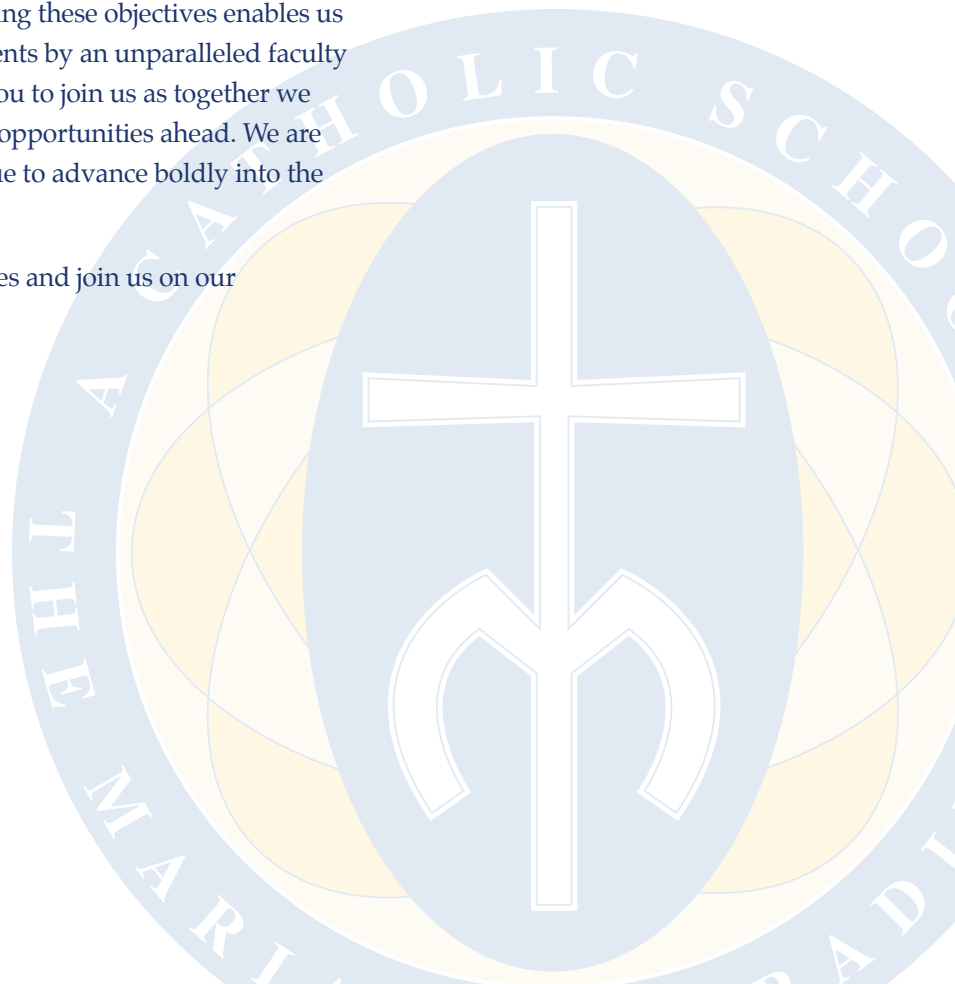
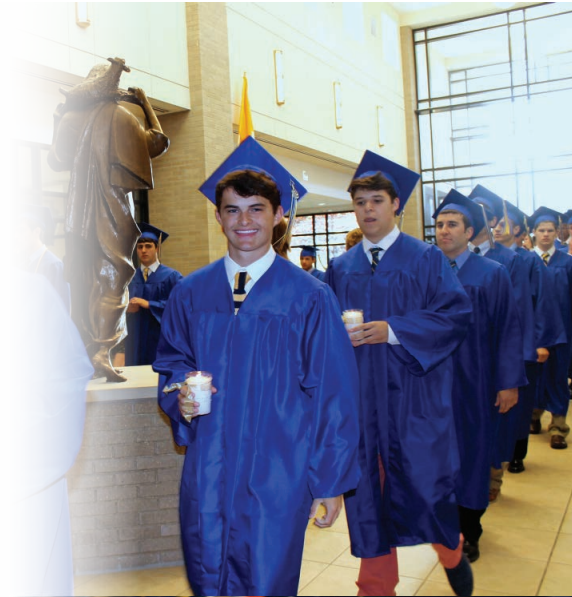

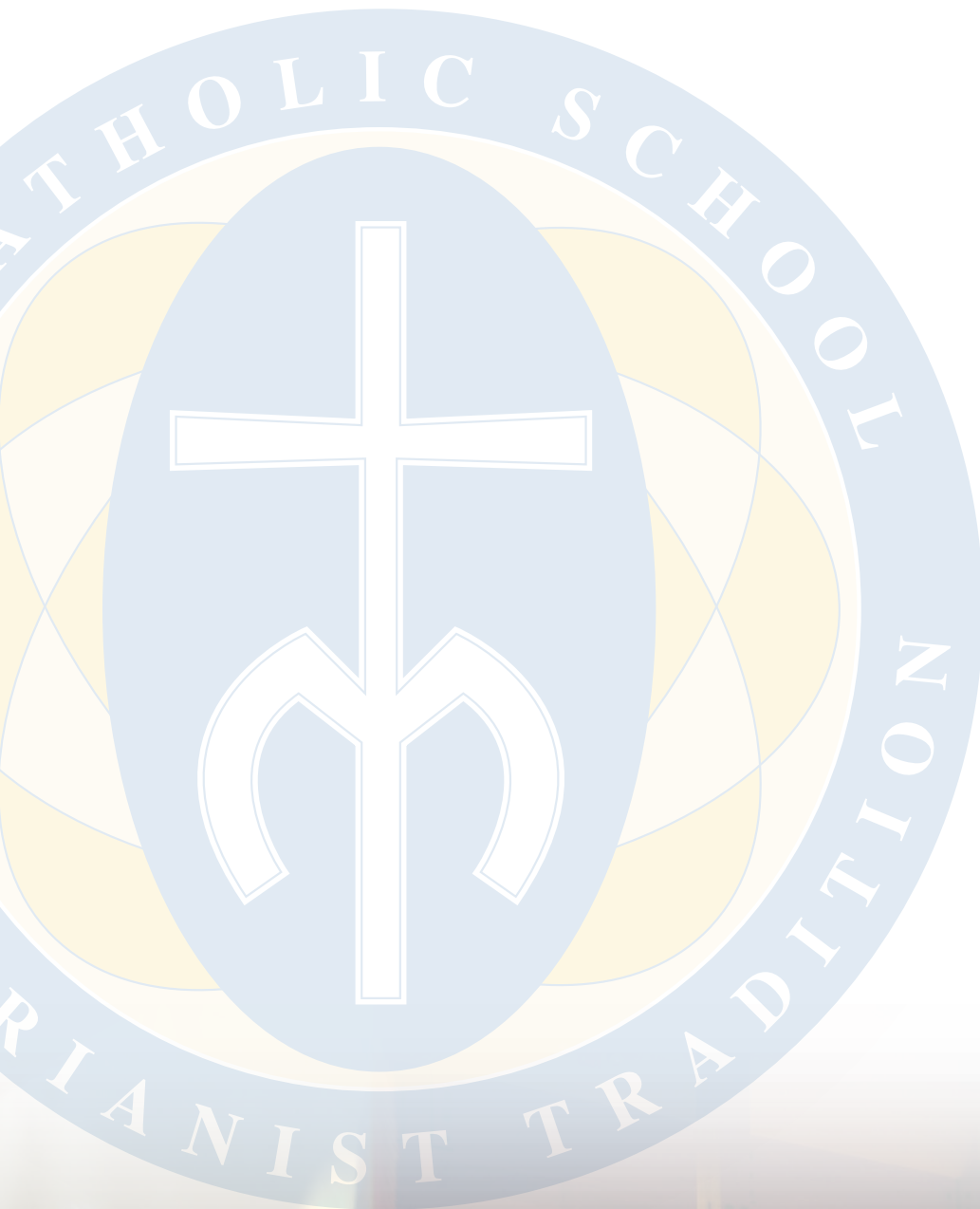
Our high-reaching plan speaks to the need to provide our students with a balanced educational experience, both mentally, physically and spiritually.

Tuition Assistance

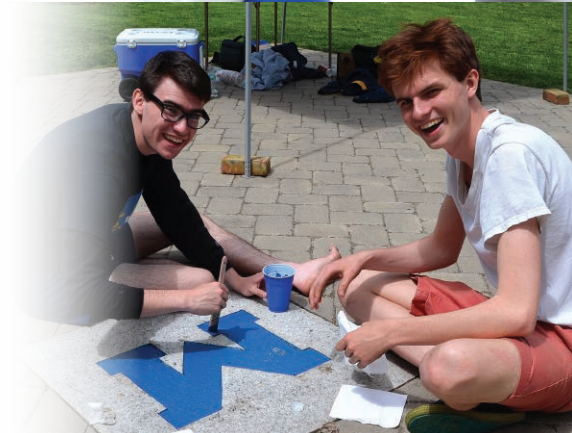

We intend to maintain our outstanding assets while also developing new facilities and facility upgrades to serve our excellent academic and athletic programs.

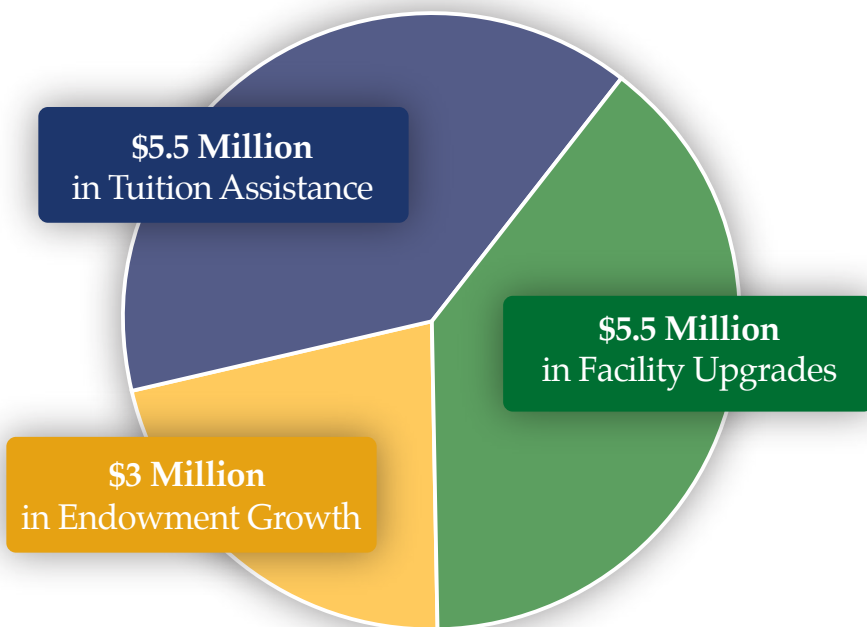
Endowment
